The Idea is to have people contribute in the re-creation of the design book, Designing the 21st Century, by making in their own unique codes in the page they have selected.

Each participants leaves a mark or code in the book that is placed within the locker; The book is transformed by the act of each participants, through their personalised markings or codes writen in the pages, and the book will be re-created as a whole new concept book.

The book: "Designing the 21st Century" (published by Taschen/Edited by Charlotte and Peter Fiell) Color Markers, glue, instructions

How it works:

- Participants pick a color marker.

After looking through the book, the participants pick out a page they like the most then add their personal code in the page (e.g. drawings, words, or anything they wish)
They express your own code VISUALLY in the chosen page.

- The participant put the book back in the locker.
